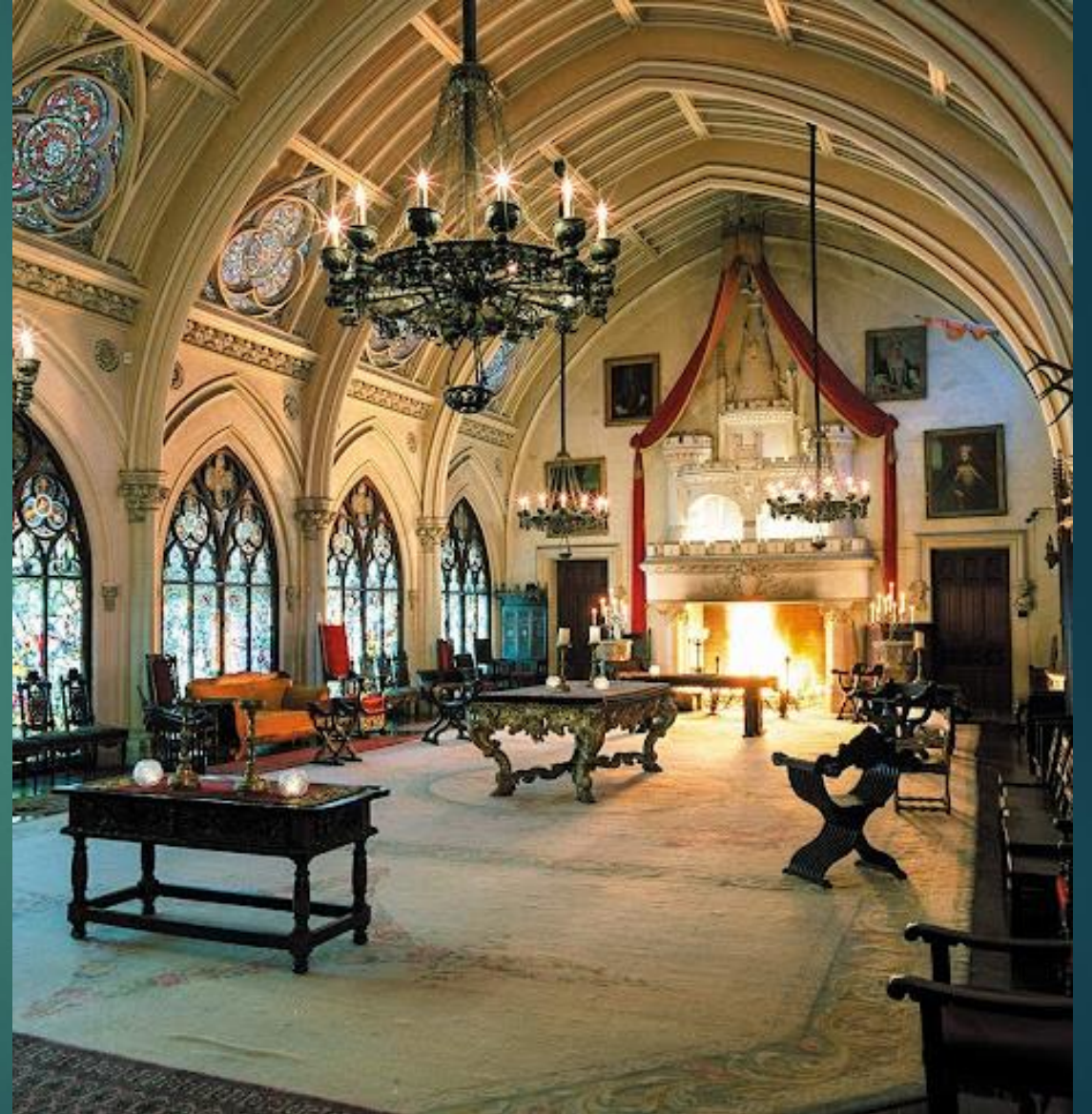
Historic Ivey Lodge

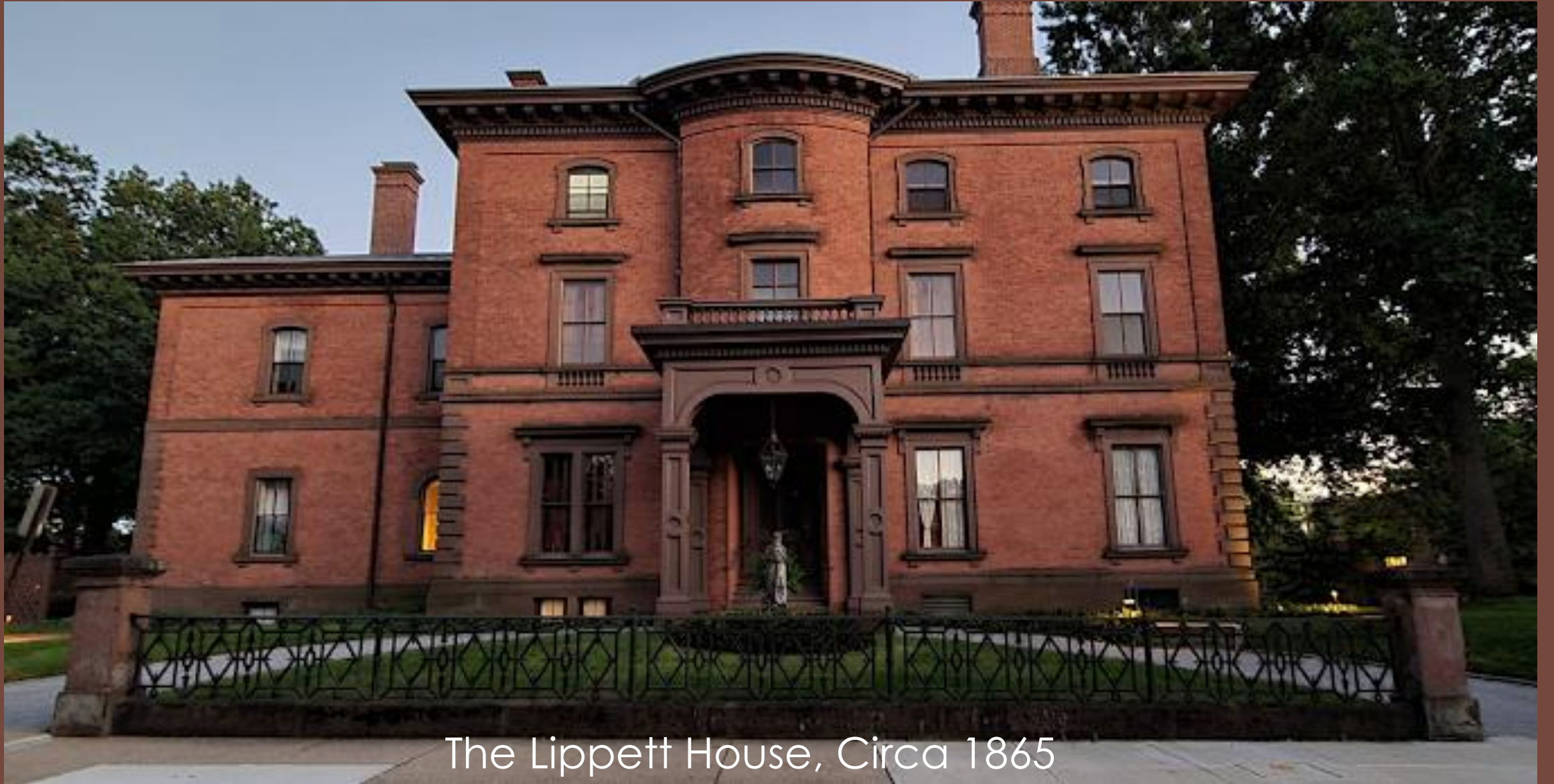












The Lippett House, Circa 1865

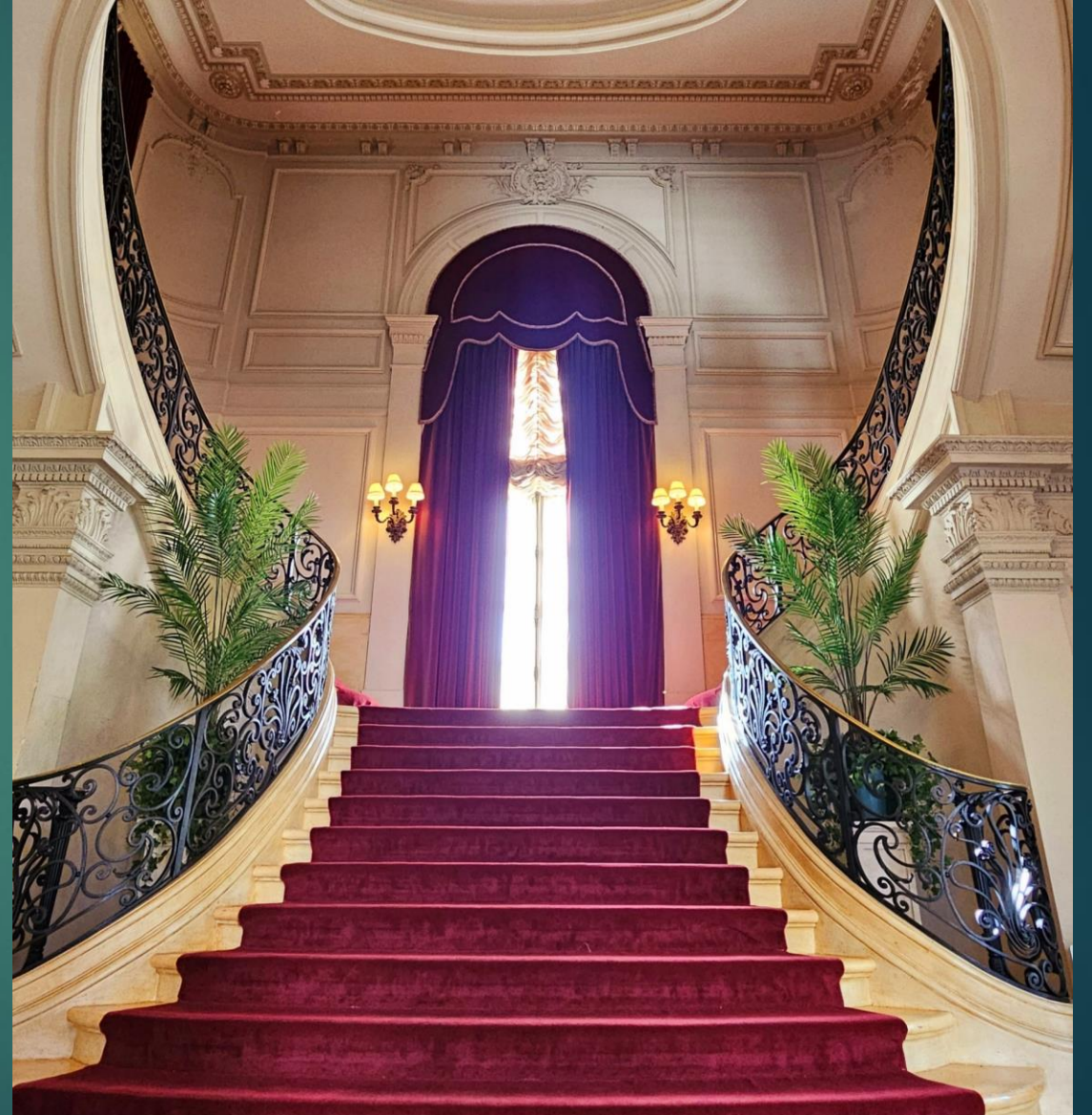
